
#### MINISTERS' FELLOWSHIP SCHEDULE

"Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and truth" I John 3:18 (NASB).

The churches of Buncombe Baptist Association come together many times and in many ways all through the year to reach out into the community with the love of Christ Jesus. Why? Because you have personally been impacted by the love of God in a very real way that has changed and transformed your lives, and the love of Christ compels you (2 Cor. 5:14) to take the Gospel into your community.

How? The possibilities are wide open. One example is the I-26 Ret Area Ministry. On October 20, 2018, eight churches sent teams to east and west bound sides, to provide free coffee to travelers on that Saturday. Working in three-hour shifts from 7am to 7pm, they had many opportunities to talk with people, give a Bible, a salvation bracelet, and other items, and share the love of Jesus. Thank you, Buncombe Baptists for giving time and energy!

A second example is the Christmas Red Box Ministry.
Together, through the WMU of our churches, you prepared
371 boxes to share with inmates at the Women's Correctional
Center in Black Mountain and with patients at the Women's
Rehab facility in Black Mountain. Thank you for giving and
sharing God's love in a real way!

Still a third way you reach even beyond your own community is by donating used Sunday School literature, Bibles, hymnals and devotionals that find homes in places around the world.
