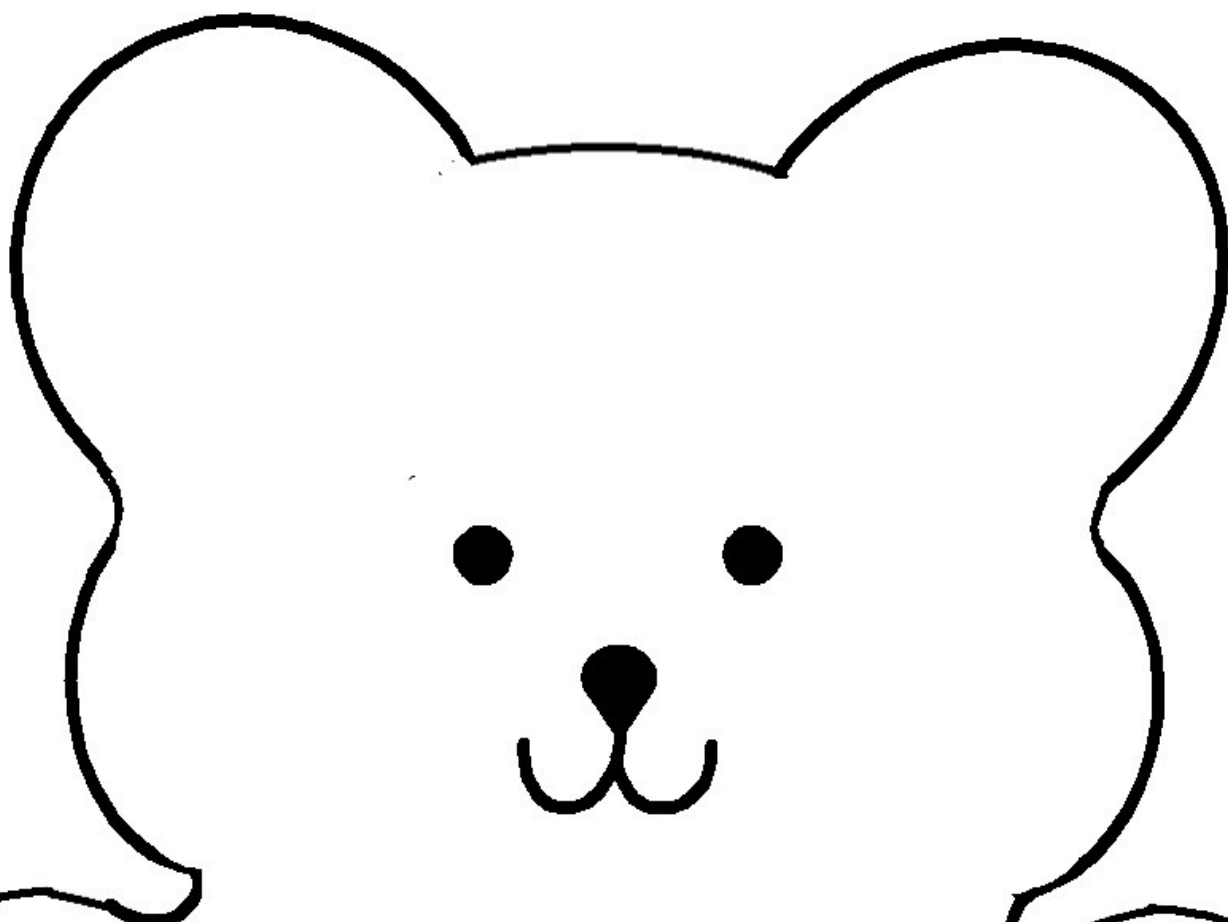


These teddy bears are given to the children who come to the Missions/3:16 Booth and those who are treated at the Medical/Dental Bus. This is an easy project which gives tremendous benefits. Finished bears can be brought to the Buncombe Baptist Resource Center by September 1. Bears should be 10.5 inches tall. Add 1-inch allowance around pattern. NOTE: This pattern fits legal-sized paper. If printed on letter-sized paper, it will be too small.



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Trace from cardboard pattern to material, both front and back.
2. Use a soft fabric of your choice.
3. With right sides together, machine sew together, twice.
4. Leave open on bottom for stuffing.
5. Turn right side out.
6. Stuff with poly-fill.
7. Sew ribbon bow around the neck.
8. DO NOT USE BUTTONS FOR EYES.
9. If desired, name of church can be put on back.
10. Draw or sew a heart with "Jesus Loves You" printed in the center of the heart.



Leave open for stuffing.
