## History of Barnardsville Baptist Church

- The Buncombe Baptist Association was formed in September 1882. Big Ivy Baptist (Original name for Barnardsville Baptist) joined as a member in 1883.
- The Church was organized in 1821 with the original name of Big Ivy Baptist. It was located on the site of the church Barnardsville Church of God.
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> building was built in 1900 near the Barnardsville Elementary site and burnt in 1916. If you look in the front of the current church, there is a Bible that survived the fire.

- The present building erected in 1921 and the name changed to Barnardsville Baptist Church.
