This fall I have been privileged to be part of several mission adventures where God's love was shared.

First, ServeNC presented opportunities to reach out in local communities to share with our neighbors. In my local church, I

was a participant in visiting local businesses, sharing a loaf of sweet bread while letting employers know we appreciate their service in our community. Also, your associational staff provided a home cooked meal for an EMS organization near us.

Second, I had the opportunity to be part of a mission team led by Rev. Johnny Byrd to the Baltimore, Maryland and Washington, DC area. We assisted three churches in ministry for six days. Each church was a recent new church plant sponsored by the North American Mission Board. The first church was East Baltimore Graffiti Church located in Baltimore. The poverty and the drug culture we saw there was overwhelming, but Pastor Charlie Brown is leading efforts to help the people be more self-sufficient while reaching out with the Gospel. The second church was Aletheia College Park. Pastor Rob Stevens is reaching students on the University of Maryland campus where there are 40,000 students and 140 culture groups. The third church was King's Church located on Capitol Hill. We were there on Sunday morning along with the 500 others at this church. Most attendees are employed at the Capitol Building in Washington. They were three very different churches but all reaching people who need the Lord!

Third, as I write this, we are in the final days of the 34th year of Fair Ministry! God has greatly blessed volunteers who have served in many capacities to help meet physical and spiritual needs for fair attendees and fair workers. The first night that I was there I talked to a young man who was amazed at what we were providing. It was special to be able to say to him, "It's free, just like the gift that God gave us by sending His Son, Jesus, giving us the opportunity to have the free gift of eternal life." Thank you for making it possible for this young man and so many others be able to experience the love of Jesus!



Many of you also participated in ServeNC, mission trips and the fair ministry this summer or fall. Thank you for blessing and in return you were blessed!
