

It continues to be one of life's greatest privileges to serve among you. In July of 2025, I am entering in to my 13<sup>th</sup> year as your Director of Missions/Associational Missions Strategist. The churches of the BBA continues to pray for sister churches, BBA staff, those who need a personal relationship with Jesus, Great Commission passion, and kingdom advancement. Two updates which needs to be made:

- ◆ The Evangelism Team continues the promotion of the "8000 New Believers by 2028!" At present we have received confirmation of 983 baptisms in 2024. That number exceeds any number from the past 3 years. Churches reported 585 in 2023, 525 in 2022, and 333 in 2021. While the number may be short of our goal, the number is not priority. PEOPLE are our priority. CELEBRATE EACH ONE! Keep praying, sharing and see how God continues to bless!
- ♦ Baptists on Mission continues to serve in WNC and has committed to 5-7 years of rebuilding homes. As of June 4<sup>th</sup>, 283 homes have been rebuilt, 323 are in process, and 1,100 requests have been received. Pray that God continues to send teams to continue this WNC Rebuild!
